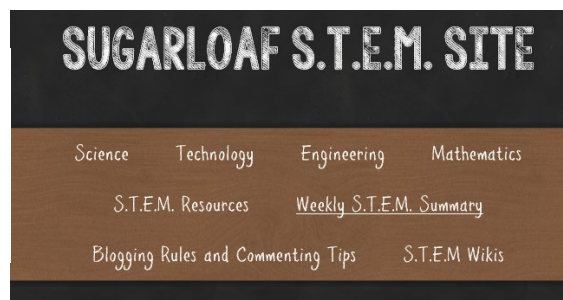

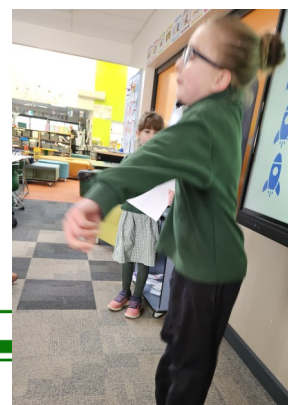


Sugarloaf STEM Blog

Week 2 and we got stuck into pattern recognition - a key feature of data and coding. In the junior grades we explored how to recognise patterns in nature, and how some patterns are not necessarily ordered but can be features of a landscape. In the Senior years we learned the basics of a algorithm pattern and how we can use patterns to make more efficient commands when entering codes for robots. We played with how to code each other using clear instructions in our algorithms to test out how clear our coding language was, then we migrated to Scratch to make our program.

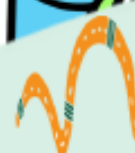
Harry Potter Science Incursion
