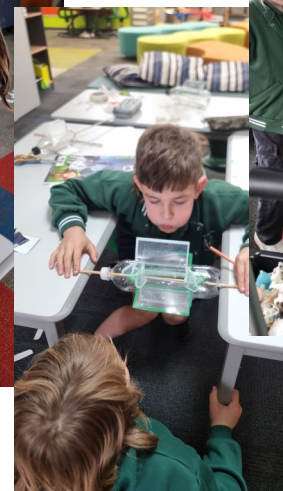
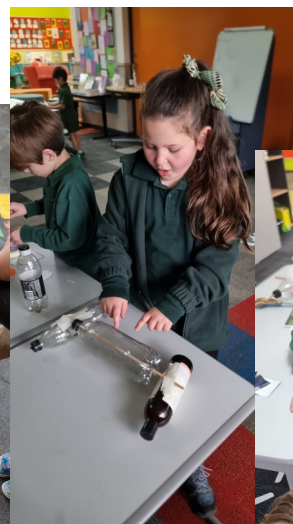


Sugarloaf STEM Blog

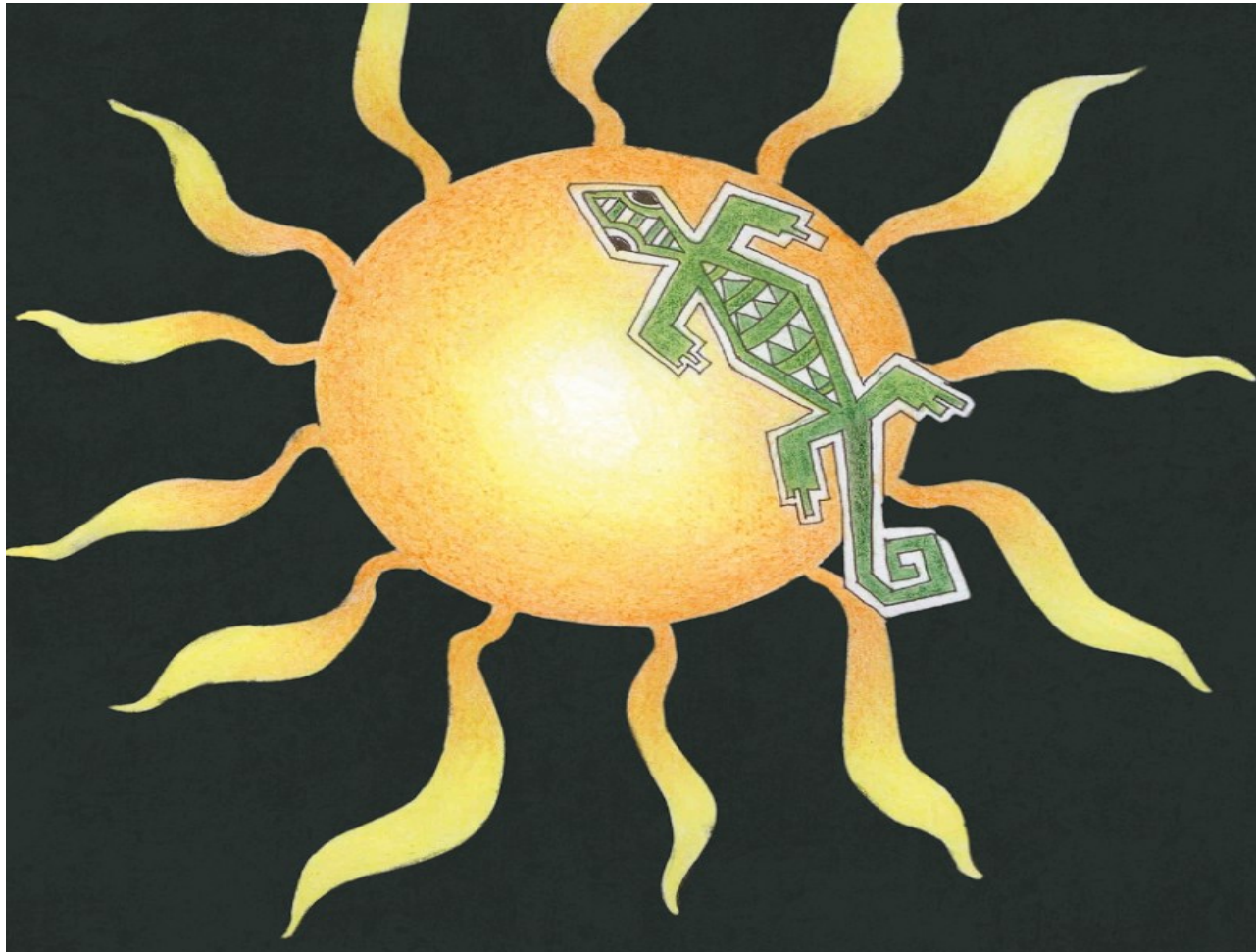
