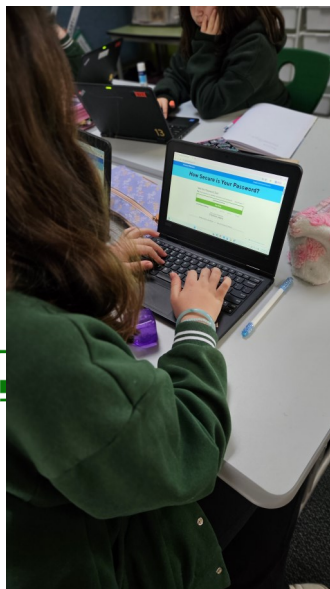
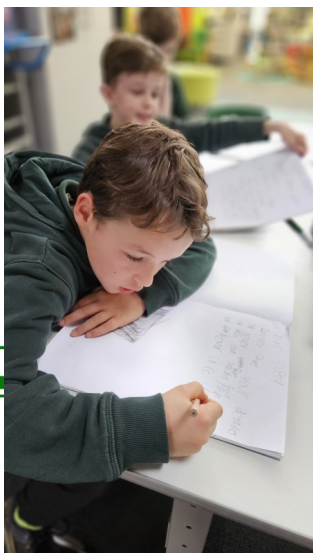


Sugarloaf STEM Blog
