ATTENDANCE: When I was analysing our attendance data for this year I made some discoveries. The good news is that we have dropped our percentage for the number of students absent for more than 20 days— it was 27% but is now 13%- what a great improvement. The statistics that still worries me is that there are 10 students who have missed between 20-29 days and 5 students that have missed over 30 days of school— that is 6 weeks— that is over half a term! When students are sick they need to stay home, the best place for their recovery is on the couch and I have no problem with big family holidays but it is the days off here and there, and the unexplained absences, that are adding up. Please be conscious of this.



This week we checked out how language is used on the online space. In the junior grades we explored how we can use language to change the meaning of a sentence. We also had a look at exploiting the features of Microsoft Word to create different documents that had different intentions. For example how could we set up a word document to show a party invite vs just taking notes of something we saw. In the senior grades we explored how language is used in media and other contexts to manipulate us and common tricks people use to trick us online. Ask your child what a False Dichotomy, Ad Hominem and Scapegoat strategy does.
