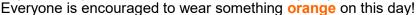


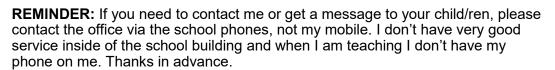

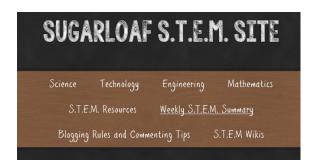








SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING & MATHS with Chan, each Monday

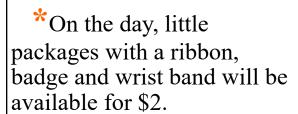
ORANGE DAY AT MKPS! Wear something orange! Thursday 21st March
