


HAT PARADE: On the last day of term– Thursday 28th March we have a Easter half court and everyone is welcome!


ORANGE DAY AT MKPS! Wear something orange! Thursday 21st March

Middle Kinglake will now run the Scholastic Book Club through online ordering rather than handling cash at school.


